“OPEN FIRES ALLOWED IN DOC L1a!”

Jetmaster Fires has recently had its Universal open fire approved by Gastec and is to be listed by HETAS on the list of approved appliances.

The Jetmaster Universal fire with a nett efficiency of 55% has been approved as a wood burner; this is the first open fire to achieve this.

Giving an estimated Carbon Credit of 160kg/yr in a 100m² house.

With this approval builder and architects can now continue to build and specify open fires in the home, even with the stringent new regulations of document “L”. The new legislation potentially limited the construction of an open fire in new dwellings, but joy of the open fire has been saved.

Jetmaster’s dual heating system where convected air is heated through a separate chamber, this coupled with traditional radiant heat offers a fantastic heat output, with all the ambiance of an open fire.

Standing air losses are also reduced as the Jetmaster fire has a damper mechanism that closes the fire down to within 3% of the flue opening when the fire is not in use, once again also improving the efficiency within the home.

All of this along with Jetmaster’s NO SMOKE GUARANTEE is bound to make Jetmaster a popular choice with builders, architects and homeowners alike.
